Accreditation procedure at Charisma University: Institutional accreditation: Resumption

Dear Dr. Okpala,

At the meeting on 24 September 2019, the Accreditation Commission discussed the institutional accreditation of Charisma University. The accreditation procedure has been suspended due to several deficiencies.

The wording of the decision of the decision taken was sent to you by letter dated 24 October 2019. The Charisma University has submitted the documents for the fulfilment of the points of criticism in due time. These were forwarded to the technical committee responsible at ACQUIN for review by the Standing Expert Committee responsible at ACQUIN.

On the basis of the expert report, the statement of the university and the statements of Standing Expert Committee, the Accreditation Commission of ACQUIN has passed the following resolution at its meeting on 24 March 2020 after detailed discussion, the following resolution was passed:

Charisma University is for the first time institutionally accredited without conditions. The accreditation is limited until 30 September 2028.

The following recommendation is given for the further development:

- Graduates should be provided with a transparent and comprehensive record of their achievements (for instance based on the diploma supplement template developed by the Council of Europe, European Commission and UNESCO).

For the accreditation of the Institutional accreditation a certificate with the seal of ACQUIN is issued and attached to this letter.

On behalf of ACQUIN I thank you very much for your confidence and the good cooperation. I wish you all the best and success for your programmes.
